

## Grace and Flavour Fruit Trees (January 2025, updated from May 2017)

As at January 2025 a total of 73 fruit trees are planted in three distinct areas:

1. Along the east and west sides of Hollier Avenue – 50 fruit trees
2. Along the garden side of the west wall – 10 fruit trees (+1 Fig)
3. In the “Orchard area” by the car park and allotments – 12 fruit trees

Of the 73 trees, Eating/All rounder Apple:17; Crab Apple:3; Cooking Apple:8 ; Pear: 17; Plum: 18; Gage:5; Quince: 4; Fig:1

Notes:

1. In February 2016, of the ten originally planted cherry trees at Grace & Flavour, nine cherry trees were removed. All ten cherry trees were in poor health, suffering from canker, subject to severe aphid infestations and did not yield any fruit. The healthiest cherry tree, a Cherry 'Sunburst' on a Colt rootstock, was transplanted in February 2016 along the west wall to the north of the blackberries. This tree, like the other nine cherry trees, suffers from canker and severe aphid infestations and has not yielded any fruit. The tree was due to be retained for a period of two years and then an assessment made whether this tree should also be removed.
2. In winter 2017, two diseased and dead Gage 'Reine Claude Bavay' trees (original position Hollier Avenue and orchard area by car park) were replaced respectively by a Plum 'Victoria' and a Quince 'Meeches Prolific'.
3. In 2022 (?) the last Cherry was removed from the west wall as it had not produced fruit and replaced by a Fig.
4. In winter 2023/24 a diseased (canker) Plum 'Czar' (49) was replaced by another Plum 'Czar'.
5. In January 2025 the Quince in Hollier Avenue was removed as it was producing hardly any fruit and was replaced by Plum 'Victoria'.
